The Central School of Speech and Drama, University of London, is pleased to announce the availability of ten new  
**EMERGENT INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS**  
for the undergraduate study of applied theatre and theatre practices

The scholarships **enable** successful non-EU candidates to **undertake** a BA (Hons) course in one of the following areas, with their third year fee reduced to £3,317, representing a discount of approximately £13,030 (figures calculated at July 2009).

**International Scholarships are available for 2010 entry in the following areas:**

#### BA (Hons) Theatre Practice

- Theatre Sound (UCAS code WW34)
- Design for the Stage (UCAS code W461)
- Theatre Lighting Design (UCAS code W450)
- Performance Arts (UCAS code W440)
- Puppetry (UCAS code W441)

**BA (Hons) Drama, Applied Theatre and Education** (UCAS code W490)

#### Eligibility

- You will need to have been offered a place to begin one of the above programmes in October 2010 (applications made through normal **procedures**, see prospectus and [www.cssd.ac.uk](http://www.cssd.ac.uk) for details.)
- In making your application, you agree **to abide** by the academic **judgement** of the Scholarship Awarding **Panel** (comprising the **Dean** of Studies, the Admissions Tutor of the relevant course and the Admissions Manager.)
- You agree to register and start your course in October 2010 – the Scholarship award cannot accompany **deferred** entry
- You agree to undertake some limited amount of ambassadorial work as an

**Application Process**

In order to apply for an International Scholarship you must **apply** for and be offered a place on one of the following courses in the normal way using the following UCAS codes (see www.cssd.ac.uk, or call +44 (0) 20 7722 8183 for applications advice and information). Upon **receipt** of your offer, return by email, an application letter which explains why you think you are **eligible** for an International Scholarship, in no more than 1250 words. Please read the section on www.cssd.ac.uk entitled *The Central Experience* and *International Students*, and then structure your letter using the following **headings**:

1. My reasons for wanting to study my chosen discipline in London
2. What I can gain from being an international student at The Central School of Speech and Drama, University of London
3. What I can contribute as an international student at The Central School of Speech and Drama, University of London
4. How an international perspective will help me in my professional life beyond Central.
5. Difficulties I anticipate in being an international student at The Central School of Speech and Drama, University of London

The panel will use the following criteria in making the **awards**:

- The ability of the candidate to demonstrate a clear understanding of the creative advantages and disadvantages of international discourse in their chosen discipline
- A mature sense of what to expect as an international student
- An indication of what the student might be able to contribute as an ambassador for the International Scholarship scheme at Central School of Speech and Drama

**Deadline** for application: 30 April 2010  
 Decision will be announced in May.

**Please note that the scheme is competitive, and the decision of the panel is final. The Central School of Speech and Drama, University of London reserves the right not to award scholarships in the absence of suitable applications. Award winners agree to be named as Emergent International Scholars.**
